The course is presented in 11 Modules, using analogies and a dialog that is easily understood in the medical profession.

- Module 2: Hearing
- Module 3: Cardiovascular
- Module 4: Hypertension
- Module 5: Respiratory
- Module 6: Neurological
- Module 7: Musculoskeletal
- Module 8: Diabetes Mellitus
- Module 9: Other Diseases
- Module 10: Psychological
- Module 11: Drug and Alcohol abuse

After each Module, a Review Module provides a retention-check covering all the pertinent content presented in the course, as well as, preparing the participant for their medical examiner certification test. The review module walks the participant through each question, providing the participant the opportunity to respond prior to the correct answer appearing on the screen. The review questions are presented in the same format that the participant should expect to see during the official exam.
